PURPOSE STATEMENT

Netball Central Zone (NCZ) aims to be the pre-eminent netball Zone in the country. Our vision is to produce a home grown Pulse team that wins. We do this by winning pinnacle domestic events and by dominating national selections and age group tournaments. The vision for the Pulse team is to produce winning performances using home grown talent. This implies identifying talented players, developing their individual skills and building winning team performances.

The purpose of the Apprentice Coach, Central Pulse role is to support the Pulse coaching staff to develop and implement the Zone's performance plan, specifically in relation to NCZ's high performance coach succession planning. The position of Apprentice Coach is a pathway opportunity for a coach with long term career aspirations to coach at an elite level and in the immediate short term, wishing to further his/her coach understanding and expertise.

As this is a developmental role, there is no salary or other payment attached to it.

POSITION

To be eligible for appointment as Apprentice Coach, NCZ must be satisfied that the preferred candidate fulfils the following criteria:

- Primary residence is in New Zealand
- Has the potential to develop and implement an effective high performance program that grows and supports elite and developing elite players
- Is committed to working with, and achieving the objectives of, the high performance strategic objectives of both NCZ and NNZ
- Demonstrates a commitment to on-going personal development as a coach

The role of Apprentice Coach is part-time and appointment will be for the 2020 season, commencing September 2019, with a review to take place after 12 months and this is a non-paid role.
